Cookie Policy

The UK government has updated the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations in response to the EU Privacy Directive. In light of this the [Information Commissioner's Office](#) has provided guidance on the EU Cookie Law which came into effect in May 2012.

The UK Health Forum (UKHF) is currently in the process of auditing the use of cookies across its sites. Our websites use certain types of cookies, e.g. registering and logging into a website, but we aim to keep these to a minimum and we are not using these for commercial purposes, or for any research purposes other than understanding how visitors use our websites. We do this only to evaluate and report to funders where we need to, e.g. website hits. We do not store these data anywhere. We do not use your personal information for any evaluation or research.
